The discussion also included restrictions on commercial/business advertisements.

Bruce Patton, North Airpark HOA (NPHOA) President, has reviewed this communique and we both agree that this reminder should be for the entire Airpark.

The Roster

By law, homeowner associations are required to keep a record of all property owners within its boundaries. Decades ago, with the consent of the community, data from the IAHA and NPHOA records were utilized to create, maintain, and distribute an Airpark Roster of contact information.

The Roster contains personal contact information, please do not provide it to anyone outside the Airpark.

The Block Herald System

The Block Herald for the Airpark community is a volunteer organization and does not come under the jurisdiction of IAHA or NPHOA. However, there has been an unwritten protocol (based on community concerns) that the **Block Herald system should not be used for politically persuasive messages or commercial/business advertising.** Out of respect for community expectations, Please refrain from doing so.
